## Mrs. Mathews' Class Newsletter January 2-4

**Theme: Kings and Queens** 

Reading: We are starting a new integrated unit focusing on Kings and Queens. This unit integrates social studies from the common core into the reading curriculum. In the skills portion we are now in Unit 6. The main focus of this unit is now on blending, learning consonant cluster, solidifying letter names



and rhyming words. We will start to work with "tricky spelling" with different digraphs and schwas and learn how some letters make more than one sound. This is the unit where the big books that we read as a whole class are now also used in reading groups as independent reads. We will provide ample opportunities for reading practice, repeated oral reading as well as practice fluency and comprehension by using story questions.

## Math

We are now in chapter 7 which focuses on representing writing and counting the number 11-19. Remember to do the homework daily at home but do not return it to school. Some of the students are still really struggling with the beginning skills we have already covered. Please take advantage of this time with your student. These concepts are the base for your child's math success in the future.
